Direct benefit Transfer (DBT) is the nutritional support for the on treatment TB patients the scheme is known as Pradhan Mantri Nikshay Poshan Yojna for which every patient gets Rs. 500 for their nutritional benefit. It was introduced by Honorable PM of India and came in effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018. The district of Sonitpur, Assam paid the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest DBT among the small state category of India.

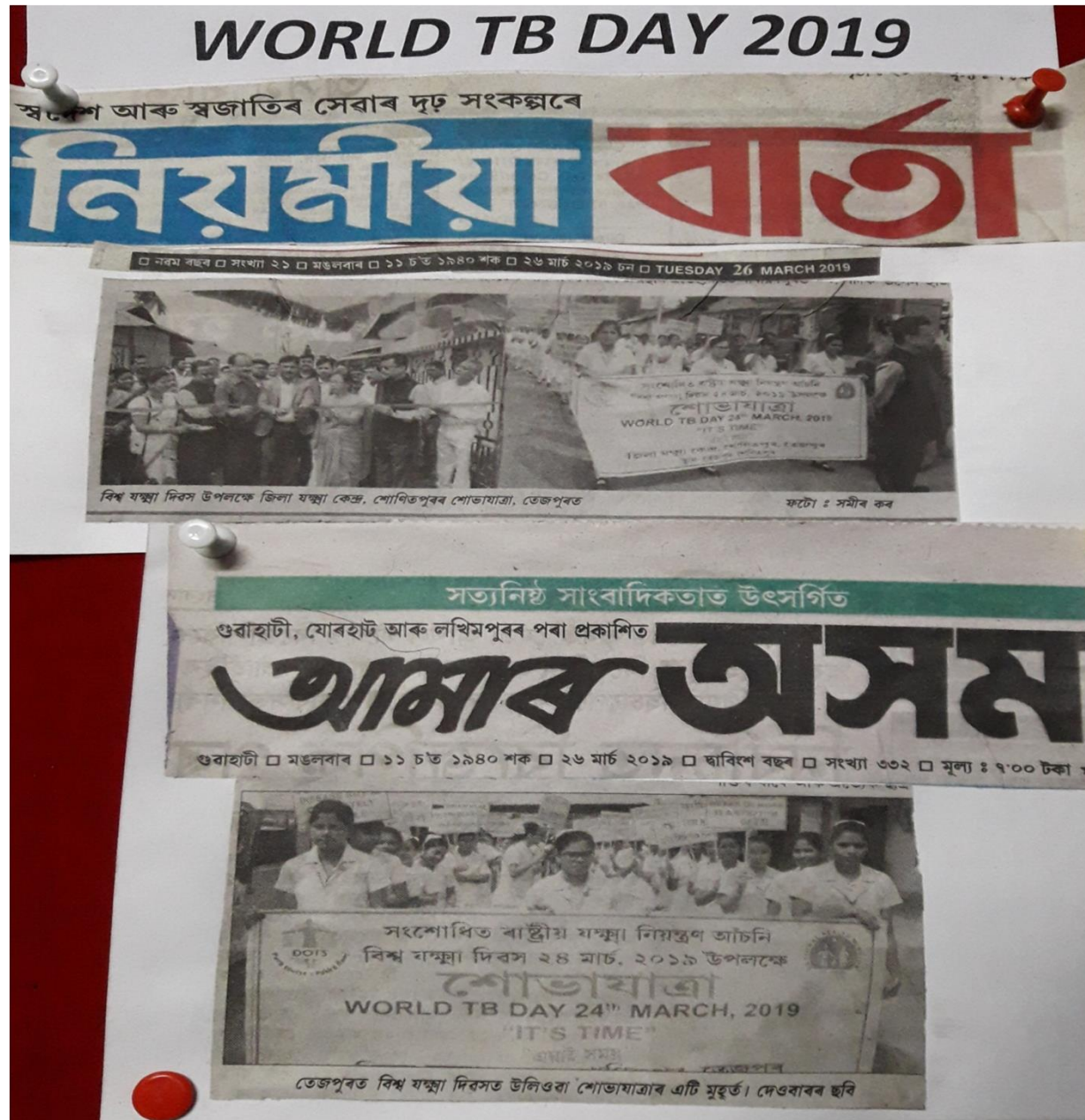

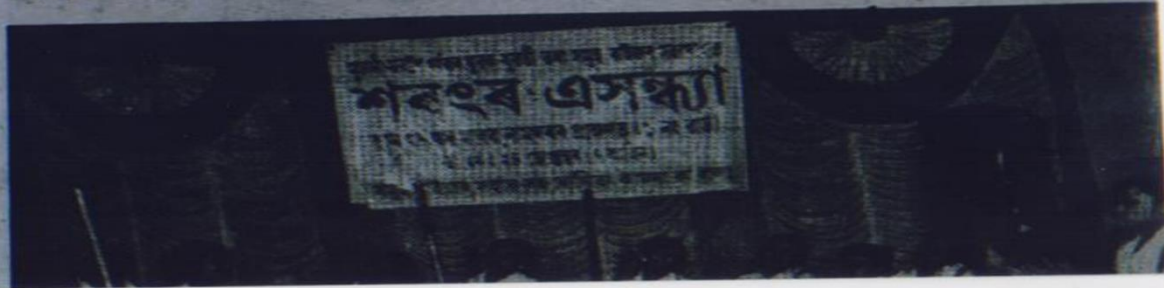

## *'Stigma main hindrance in the path of detection and treatment of TB'*

**TEZPUR, Nov 17:** The first ever meeting of the District Tuberculosis Forum in the presence of

Joint Director, Health Services, Dr. Krishna Kempraj and various stakeholders was held at the conference hall of the Deputy Commissioner's office on Saturday to discuss about increasing community participation in a bid to eradicate tuberculosis.

The meeting which was chaired by Deputy Commissioner Manoj Kumar Deka, discussed various issues related to reducing stigma and discrimination associated with the disease, facilitating nutritional support for patients, establishing linkage with social welfare schemes, re-

habilitation and social security of patients, and on creating awareness about various government schemes and programmes and treatment facilities available.

Speaking on the occasion, State IEC/ACSM officer Dr Paranjy Bordoloi informed all present that a paradigm shift had occurred in the effort to curb tuberculosis with efforts being stepped up to eliminate the disease from the country by 2025. As such, focus is being laid on making quality TB diagnosis and treatment available to all members of the community while stepping up activities to detect new cases for the purpose of eradicating of the disease, he said.

Additional Director of Health Services-cum-SPO RNTCP, Assam, Dr. Nayan

Jyoti Das said stigma associated with the disease was the main hindrance in the path of detection and treatment of tuberculosis. He spoke about new policies that had been formulated for eradicating the disease along with new diagnostic methods and different lines of treatment that were being adopted for curing tuberculosis patients. He also informed that clinical establishments and health workers are now liable to attract penalty under provisions of Section 269 and 270 of the Indian Penal Code for failing to notify public health authorities about tuberculosis cases.

Deputy Commissioner Manoj Deka asked the health department officials to lay special focus on tea garden areas and to carry out intensive sensitization cam-

paigns in these areas. Additional Deputy Commissioner Kishan Kumar Sarma said there was need to come up with innovative means and ways to detect tuberculosis cases in the district. District TB Officer Dr Sanjoy Roy requested active cooperation and support from all stakeholders to make this effort a success. As per decision taken in the meeting, an awareness camp will be held at Rangapara Railway Field on the sidelines of the Shramik Kalyan Divas to be held on November 23. Three TB champions who were also present in the meeting shared their success stories of complete cure from tuberculosis and thanked the health department and doctors for their guidance and support in helping them overcome the disease.



With reference to the subject cited above I am to inform you that a Govt. of India Gazette on TB has been published regarding notification of all TB patients making mandatory to all health establishments including private medical practitioner, private laboratories and all pharmacies to the appropriate authority. TB has been declared as notifiable disease on 2012 and since then this process underwent in our district. However it has been observed that all notifications are not available and are not send regularly.


